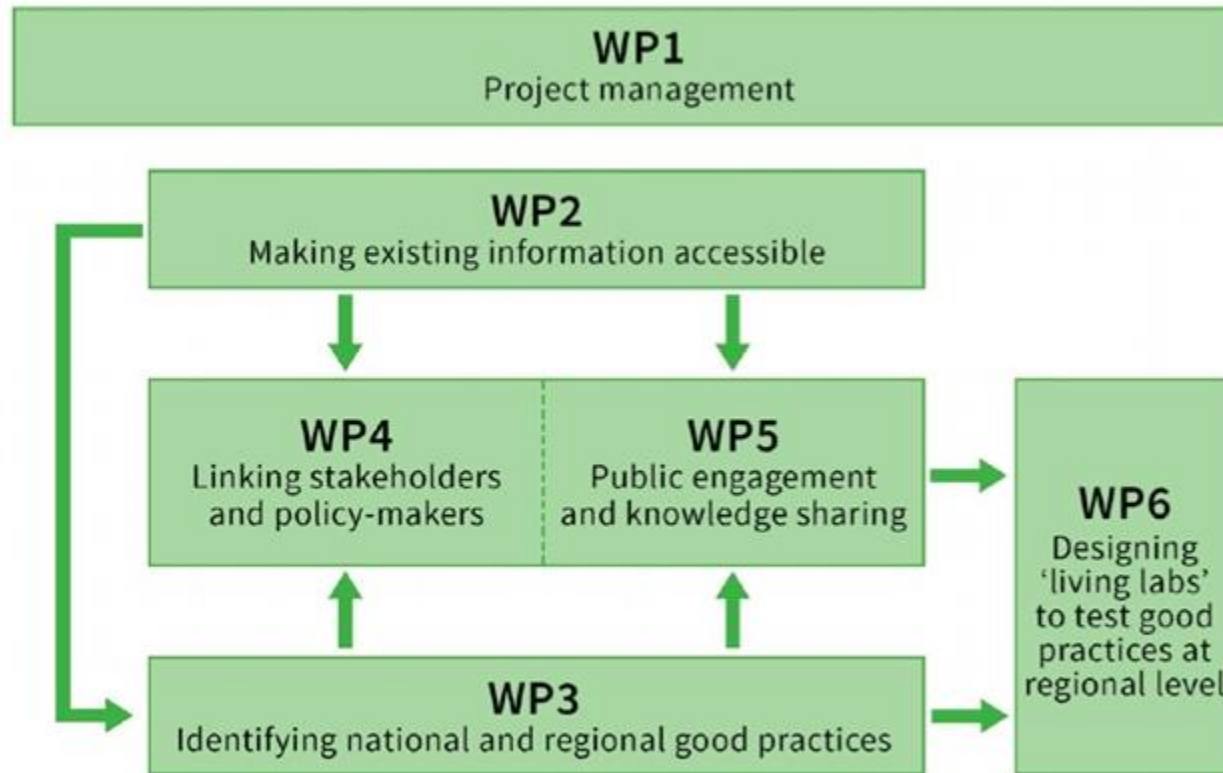

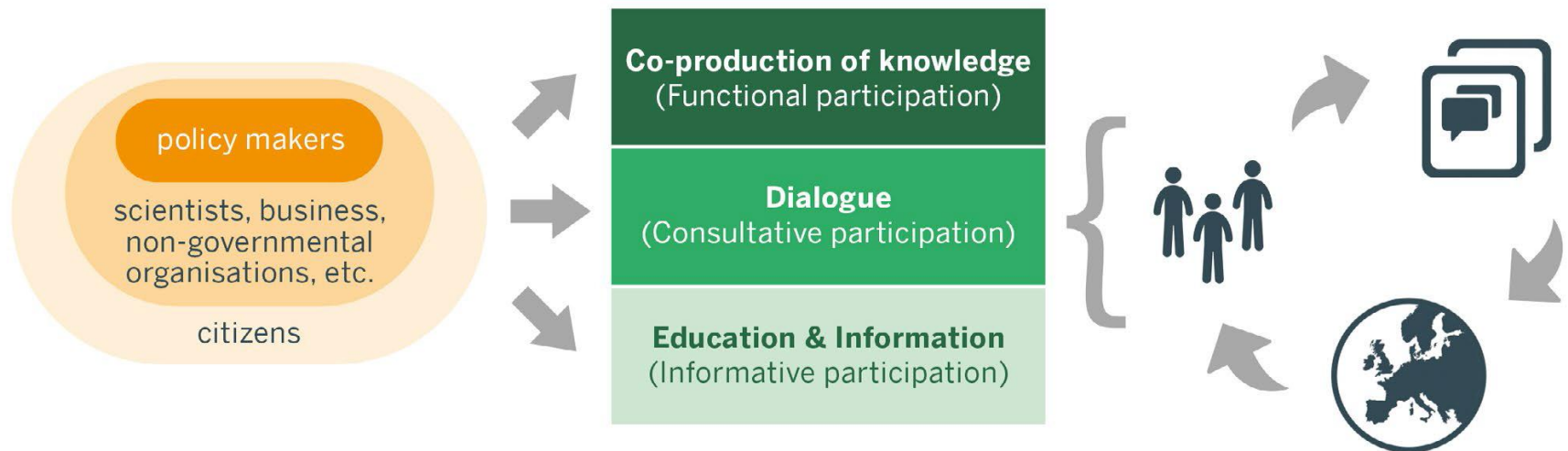

Project structure



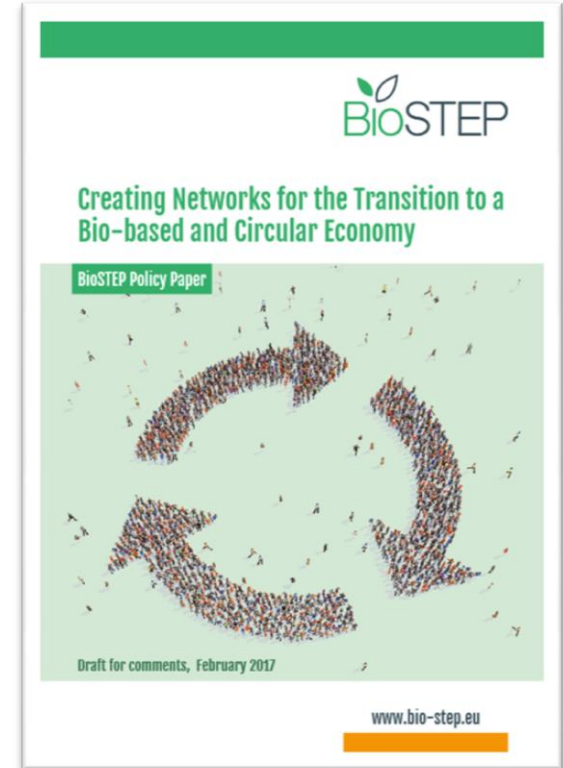
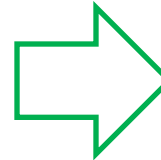
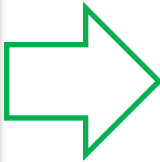
BioSTEP's conceptual framework
